What does the Youths' Romantic Relationships Survey have to say? (2015 - Number 2 of 4)

TRUE OR FALSE?

In the 2nd cycle of high school, **not all** youths in couples **have sexual intercourse.**

↳ **TRUE**

Among youths in couples, **1 out of 2 has not yet had sexual intercourse.**



HAVING «SEXUAL INTERCOURSE» MEANS:

vaginal penetration

OR

anal penetration

OR

oral-genital contact, which means a contact between the mouth and the penis or the vulva

The Youths' Romantic Relationships (YRR) Survey is a study conducted in Quebec between 2011 and 2014 among 2nd cycle high school youth ages 14-18 years. A total of 8194 youths completed the questionnaire at least once. The study is led by Martine Hébert, Ph.D., and funded by the Canadian Institutes for Health Research (CIHR #103944).

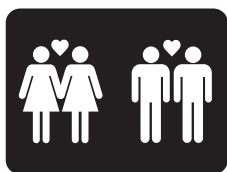
